GROOMING STANDARDS

GROOMING GUIDELINES

1. A clean, neat appearance is a must.
2. Hair must be natural color, neat and groomed and not to extend below collar line. Ladies must wear their hair in a bun on inspection days. On non-inspection day ladies may wear their hair down and pulled out of face. Gentlemen must have their hair neatly cut and neatly groomed above their ears.
3. Fingernails must be clean and trimmed. No nail polish.
4. Female cadets: Small studs for earrings and no jewelry. Male cadets: No earrings or jewelry. Watches are allowed.
5. Shirts should be clean and tucked in.
6. Shorts and pants should be clean and neatly pressed. Pant **MUST** be worn on inspection days. (Inspection calendar with dates will be provided)
7. Sneakers/boots must be all black. Boots need to be kept polished.
8. Socks should be white, mid-calf to ankle length is appropriate.

As a representative of the Police Academy Magnet, it is expected that you conform to the standards of the program. If in doubt about how you should look, check with your on-site police officer or magnet coordinator.

STUDENT CONDUCT

As a student in this program, you are expected and required to conduct yourself in a respectful and professional manner at all times. Not only are you a role model to other students, you are a representative of the Los Angeles Police Academy Magnet School and also of your community.
